

Weiss Wins Bout On Guadalcanal

GUADALCANAL — (Delayed) — The clever boxing of Marine Private First Class Moe Weiss, of the Bronx, N. Y., won him an easy decision over Private Clarence Bender, U. S. A., of Hawaii, in their three-round junior middle weight fight before 4,500 service men here last night. Weiss was a member of a Marine team which won six of nine bouts from an all Hawaiian Army team.

Weiss, a fast worker, landed his lightning left jab and powerful right hook frequently. He chased Bender around the ring and caught him with left and right as the Hawaiian tried to fight out of the ropes.

A former New York professional boxer, Weiss lives at 1224 Olmstead Avenue, The Bronx.
