

2LT James Allen Callaghan

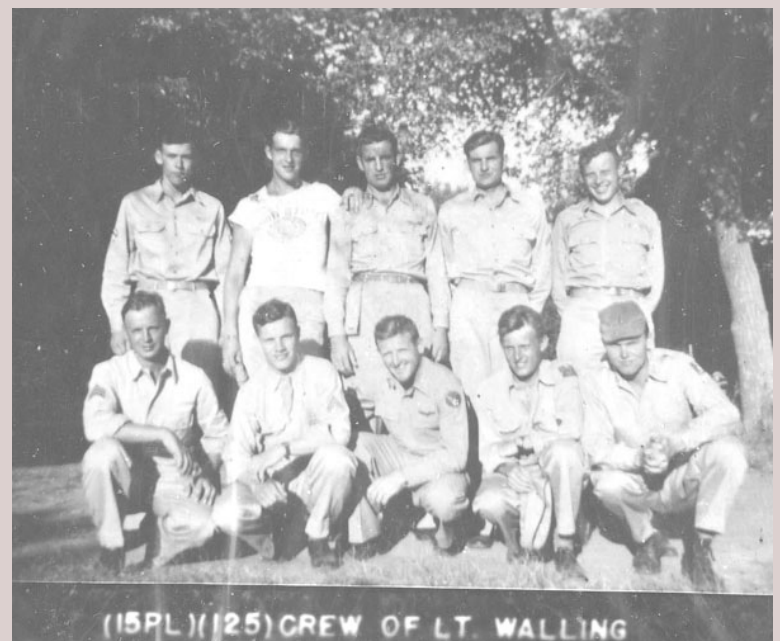
Birth: Sep. 29, 1920
Death: Dec. 18, 1944, At Sea

2nd Lieutenant Callaghan was the Bombadier-Navigator aboard U.S. Army Air Corps B-29-15-BA Superfortress #42-63413, nicknamed "Dixie Darling." While on a mission from Saipan to Nagoya, Japan, the bomber was last seen approximately 80 nautical miles from Iwo Jima. The crew of eleven were MIA/KIA. Unknown cause/location/fate. With the 497th Bombardment Group, 871st Bomb Squadron.

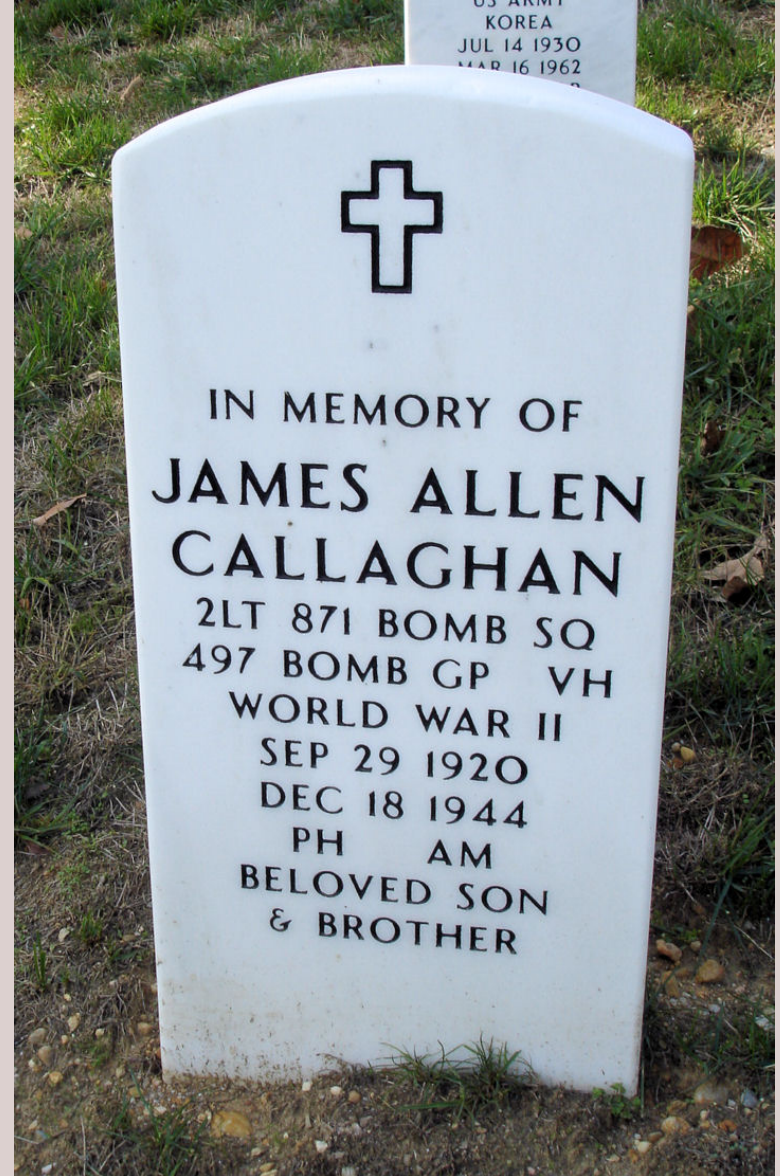
