The petition of KURT EMIL HIRSCHFELD, hereby filed, respectfully shows:
(1) My place of residence is 1410 Grand Concourse Bronx NY. (2) My occupation is physician
(3) I was born in Hamburg, Germany on October 4, 1900. My race is Hebrew
(4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on July 13, 1934 in the U. S. District Court of Southern District of New York
(5) I am married. The name of my wife Emma is Alma
we were married on Aug. 10, 1929 at Hamburg, Germany & he was born at Hamburg, Germany
on Feb. 13, 1905; entered the United States at New York NY on Dec. 12, 1934 for permanent residence therein,
and now resides at 1410 Grand Concourse, Bronx NY was not naturalized on
at _____ certificate No. _____ I have no children, and the name, date,
and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows:

(6) My last foreign residence was Hamburg, Germany. I emigrated to the United States of America from Hamburg, Germany. My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York NY under the name of Kurt Hirschfeld on June 23, 1934 on the vessel SS President Roosevelt as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached hereto.

(7) I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and sever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, of whom (which) at this time I am a subject (or citizen), and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (8) I am able to speak the English language. (9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since June 23, 1934 and in the County of Bronx this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since January 1, 1933 being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition.

(10) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization. No _____ and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:
and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.
Attached hereto and made a part of this petition for naturalization, are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States, certificate from the Department of Labor of my said arrival, and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses required by law.
