Stuart Marshall Beringer, 80, passed away on January 13, 2004. Born January 27, 1923 in New York City, he grew up in Larchmont and lived most of his married life of 54 years in Rye. He graduated from Phillips Exeter Academy, received a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry from Harvard University and a Masters degree in Business Administration from Columbia University. Beringer was a founding partner and, at the time of his death, Chairman of TM Capital Corp., in New York City; the Chairman of Servo-Tek Products, Co., Inc., Hawthorne, NJ; Chairman of Thakar Aluminum Corp., Sandusky, OH and Vice President, Advest, Inc., Rye, NY. He began his career as an investment banker at P.W. Brooks & Co., Inc., a member of the New York Stock Exchange and served as President from 1947 to 1966 under his father, Albert Frederick Beringer, the Chairman of the company. He then served as Senior Vice President of Blair & Co., Inc., NYC and W.E. Hutton & Co., NYC. In the 70's, he was the Vice President of Reynolds Securities, Inc., NYC and the President of Essex Chemical Corp., Clifton, NJ. From 1980-89, he was the Senior Vice President of Corporate Finance for Thomson McKinnon Securities, Inc. A seasoned and well-respected member of the investment banking community, during his career, he served on the Board of Directors of 30 public companies, including Essex Chemical Corp. and Lynch Communications Systems, Inc. Beringer was a veteran of the United States Navy. He was a past deacon of the Rye Presbyterian Church; a member of the American Yacht Club, Rye; Coral Beach & Tennis Club, Bermuda; The Club at Windermere, Eleuthera, Bahamas, where he had a second home. He was an avid squash and tennis player. His survivors include his wife, Alice; his sons: Stuart Stratton Beringer and Peter Marshall Beringer; two daughters-in-law, four grandchildren, two sisters-in-law, three nephews and three nieces.
