

## **AIRMAN KILLED IN INDIA**

### **Capt. Warner Marshall Jr. Dies in Crash of Troop Plane**

Capt. Warner Marshall Jr. of the Army Air Forces was killed in a crash of a troop transport plane in northeast India on Dec. 12, according to word received here yesterday. He was 34 years old. The officer was a member of the planning staff of the Army Air Forces at the recent Cairo conference, and subsequently went on a tour of the eastern theatres of war.

Before entering the Army last year, Capt. Marshall, who lived at 404 East Fifty-fifth Street, was head of an investment counsel concern here. He was graduated from Phillips Andover Academy and Yale University.

Surviving are his wife, the former Nina Tandberg of Oslo, Norway; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Warner Marshall of Tucson, Ariz., and two brothers.
